

AT A GLANCE

St. Croix is the largest and least-visited of the three U.S. Virgin Islands. It offers a charming blend of emerald-green mountains, inviting waters, and a rich history filled with tales of piracy, art, and diverse cultures.

The ship will dock right in the heart of Frederiksted, also known as 'The Freedom City,' named after being the site where the proclamation abolishing slavery on the island was read. It's just a 10 minute walk straight down the pier to reach the town, where you'll discover a mix of historic buildings, from early Danish military and neo-classical styles to late Victorian residences.

Taxis are available at the end of the cruise ship pier, and fares are set based on your destination rather than mileage, so there's no need to negotiate.

OUT AND ABOUT

Caribbean Museum Centre for the Art: This architectural gem which is steeped in history dating back to the 1780's stands as a sole museum which dedicates to preserve, promote and exhibit the arts of the Caribbean Culture.

Fort Frederik: A mid-eighteenth century Danish masonry fort built to protect the colony from pirates and privateers as well as to maintain order during times of slavery. It's around a 10-15 minute walk from the ship.

Frederiksted Historic District: Frederiksted's Historic District is a charming area of pastel-colored colonial buildings, quaint streets, and seaside charm. Stroll through town to discover local shops, cafés, and landmarks, all within easy walking distance from the cruise port.



BEST BEACHES

Just a short distance from Frederiksted, Rainbow Beach is a popular spot featuring soft white sands, beach bars, and plenty of amenities. A taxi ride costs around \$6 per person each way, or you can choose to walk there in around 30 minutes by turning left at the end of the cruise pier.

SHOPPING

Frederiksted is home to a variety of local market stalls where you can find souvenirs and handmade crafts. Lining the waterfront, these stalls offer everything from gold bracelets and bottles of rum, to nautical-themed pottery.

DO IT LIKE THE LOCALS

St. Croix, like many Caribbean islands, is a cultural melting pot. One of the great things about this island is the mix of ethnic groups and cultures that results in some amazing cuisine. As you taste your way around the island, you will experience a multitude of influences and fusions including Caribbean, African, Indian, Latin American, European and American.
