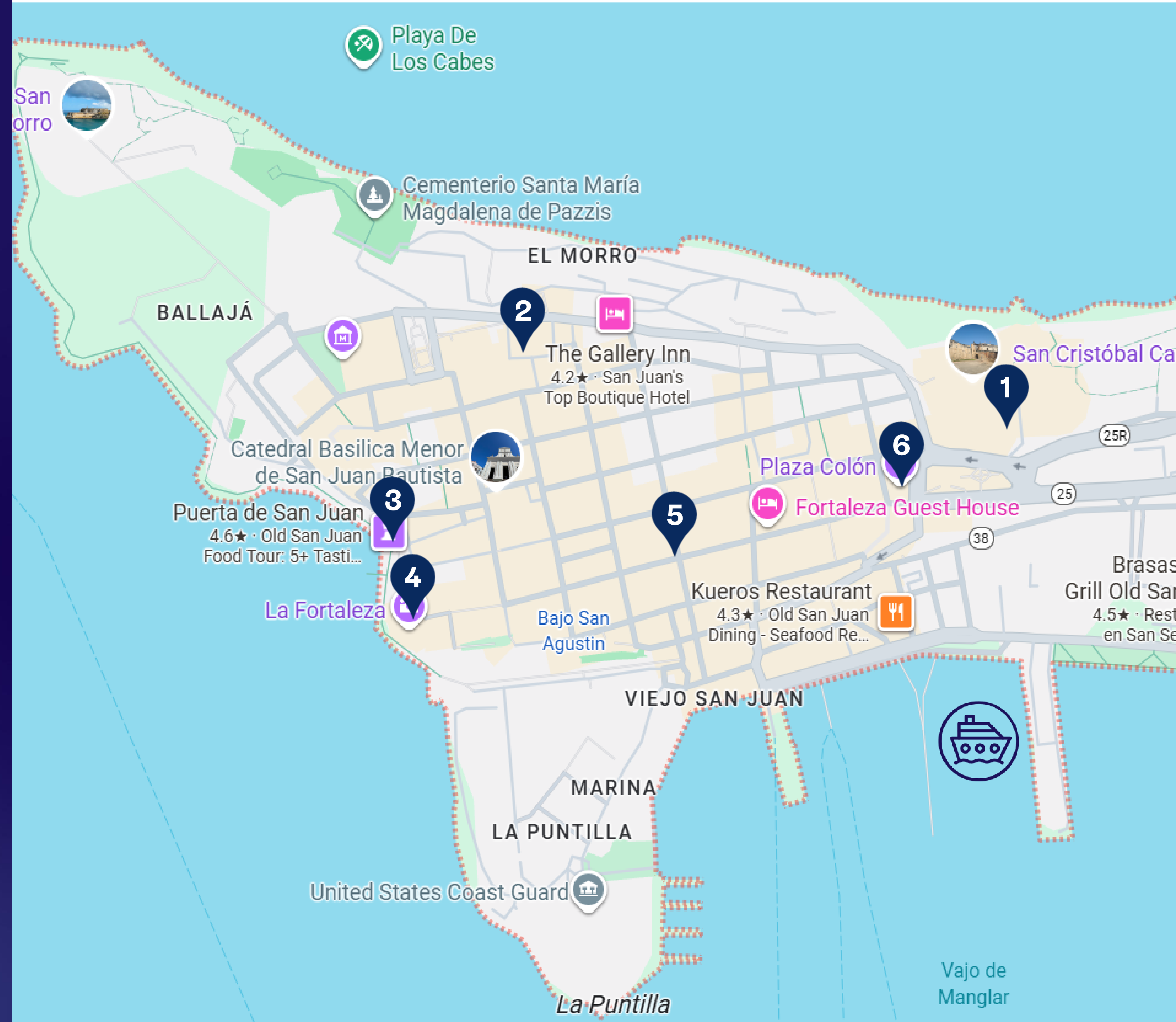

AT A GLANCE

San Juan is a vibrant Caribbean city where history meets the sea. Wander the cobbled streets of Old San Juan to see colourful colonial buildings, forts, and plazas, or enjoy waterfront cafés, lively markets, and local cuisine. With the cruise port just steps from the historic centre, it's easy to soak up the city's rich culture and charm.

From the cruise terminal, it's just a short walk to Old San Juan, where brightly coloured colonial buildings, cobblestone streets, and picturesque plazas set the scene. Explore iconic forts like El Morro and San Cristóbal, stroll along the waterfront promenade, or browse local markets and shops for souvenirs and handmade crafts. Simply soak up the lively atmosphere. Everything is within easy reach, making it effortless to experience the city's culture, history, and charm in a single day.

OUT AND ABOUT

San Cristobal Castle: Discover this UNESCO world heritage site that was built in 1765 to protect the land. You can walk the parapets, soak up the views of Old San Juan below and even squeeze through dark tunnels and a dungeon.

Fortaleza street: Fortaleza Street is the vibrant main street of Old San Juan, lined with colourful colonial buildings, shops and cafés. Perfect for a leisurely stroll, it's a great place to pick up souvenirs.

Historic City Gates: San Juan's Historic City Gates mark the entrance to Old San Juan and a step back in time. Walk through these iconic stone arches and imagine the city's colonial past, with cobblestone streets and colourful buildings waiting beyond.

BEST BEACHES

Isla Verde Beach is a series of three interconnected beaches offering up biscuity coloured sands and a true tropical vibe. There's a few beach bars and restaurants here if you fancy grabbing a bite to eat. It's around a 25 minute drive from the port. Alternatively, Condado beach is the closest beach to the cruise port and you can get here with a quick 10 minute taxi ride.

SHOPPING

If you fancy a stroll into Old San Juan, this is the perfect place to kick-start your shopping. Wander past little cafés, boutiques, colourful street art, and umbrella-filled skies. For a bigger shopping trip, a short 15-minute drive from the port will take you to Plaza Las Américas, the largest mall in the Caribbean. With over 300 stores, including Macy's, Zara, and Forever 21, there's something for everyone.

DO IT LIKE THE LOCALS

San Juan is home to some of the island's best restaurants, serving both local and international flavours. Don't miss Arroz con Habichuelas – rice and beans, a classic Puerto Rican favourite found in many Old San Juan eateries.
